

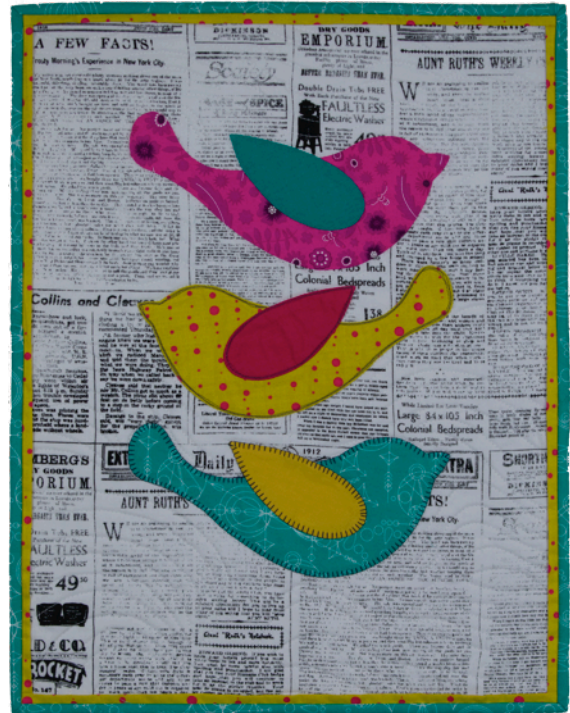
Appliqué Three Ways with Jenifer Dick

Mock hand appliqué | Contemporary | Traditional

Supply List

- **Freezer paper**—Reynolds Wrap brand is okay
- **Water soluble glue stick**—Any brand. Make sure it is clear, NOT blue or purple.
- **Elmer's school glue**
- **Invisible polyester thread**—Brand new if possible - Sulky or Superior brands are best. I DO NOT recommend Gutterman invisible thread.
- **Black or Dark Gray thread**—Make sure it contrasts with your fabric so your beautiful stitches show!
- **80/12 needle**
- **Ironing Board and Iron**—Personal size. Full size available day of workshop for those who prefer
- **3 Paris of Scissors**—For cutting paper, fabric, and a pair of sharp snips
- **Pencil**
- **Spray starch**—Not Best Press
- **Terry cloth towel**

Extra: open-toe appliqué foot—If you don't have one, bring your regular zigzag foot



Fabrics

- **1/2 yard** (or 2 FQs) for the background. Cut in half and reserve one half for the quilt backing.
- **Scraps** (at least 6" x 9" each) in three coordinating solids - light, medium and dark (or go crazy with color combinations and/or prints if you want a scrappy look)
- **3/8 yard** for binding and **1/8 yard** for flange, if desired

Before Class:

- **Prewash fabric** Glue and freezer paper often don't play well with unwashed fabric.
- **Sewing Machine** Please don't bring a machine to class you don't know how to use!

Bobbins - wind 2 bobbins before class, one with the black/gray and one with invisible thread. Only wind half-full of invisible, especially if you have plastic bobbins. If you have trouble with the invisible, try standing up the spool holder on your machine. Sometimes invisible thread wants to be upright rather than horizontal.

Experiment with stitches - we will be using a variety of stitches - zigzag, blind hem, blanket, etc. It's a good idea to familiarize yourself with these and any others you think might look good on appliqué before class. Also bring some scraps to class to practice on.
