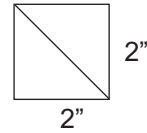


MONTH #2 of MEDALLION MYSTERY QUILT- OCQG

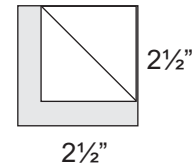
For the first border, you will need the following:

- 32–2½” squares of assorted medium-dark prints or solids
- 64– 2” squares of background fabric/s
- 4–2½” corner squares of background fabric/s

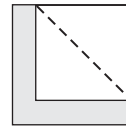
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of all 64–2” square background fabric/s.



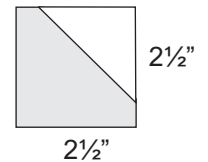
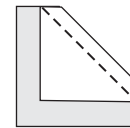
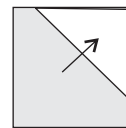
2. Place one marked 2” background square on a corner of one 2½” assorted print square, as shown. Note the placement of the marked line.



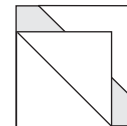
3. Stitch along the marked line.



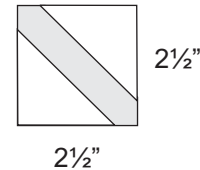
4. Press in the direction indicated and trim seam allowance ¼”. The resulting unit should be 2½ square.



5. Place a second marked 2” background square on the opposite corner of the same 2½” square, as shown. Note the placement of the marked line.

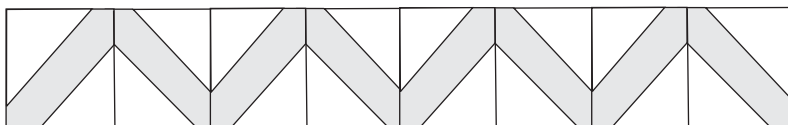
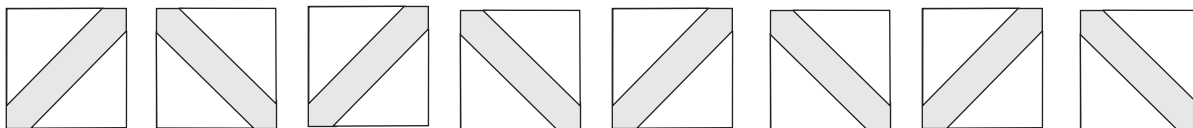


6. Repeat steps 3 and 4 to complete the unit, which should still be 2½” square.



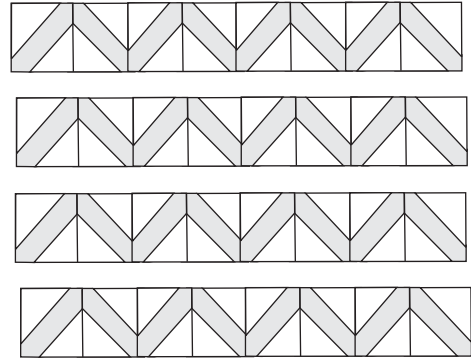
7. Repeat steps 2 through 6 for the 32–2½” squares and 64–2” background squares.

8. With right sides together, join 8 units, alternating the direction of the diagonal stripe.



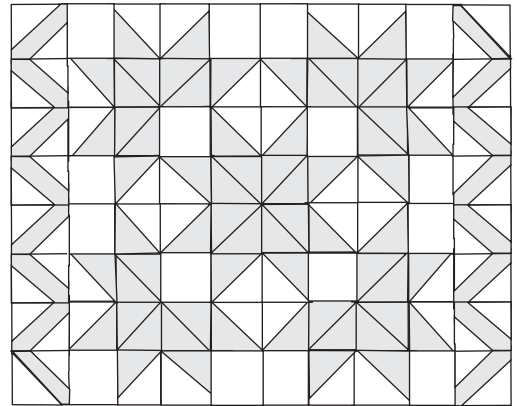
9. Press seams open to reduce bulk at the seam intersections.

10. Repeat to make a total of 4 groups of 8.  
Orientation of strip should be identical for each group.



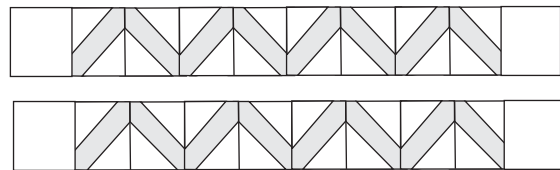
11. Join two of the joined units to opposite sides of the center block, as shown. Note the orientation of stripes.

Press seams toward center block.



12. Join 4-2½" background square to opposite ends of two of the joined units, as shown.

Press seams toward the added corner square.



13. Join these two joined units with corners added to the remaining sides of the center block, as shown.
