Supplies list

Fabric Requirements:

- 1 brown lunch bag full of scraps (smaller than fat quarters).
- 16" x 20" foundation fabric (either white or something that you don't care about sewing over)

Other Special Tools:

- Sketch Paper
- Pen
- Scissors (both fabric and for cutting fused fabric)
- Working Sewing Machine - recommend being able to straight stitch, blanket stitch and free motion quilt
- Sharp Rotary Cutter
- 6.5" x 24" rectangular ruler ... or similar size
- Stick Pins
- Thread and full bobbin – you may want to do some fancy stitching so maybe a few colors of thread
- Embellishments (no more than a brown lunch bag full) – ribbons, beads, glue, mirror, jewels
- Small cutting mat next to your machine.

Optional:

- Fabric and batting if you plan to finish and quilt your piece too ... not required for the challenge. A quilt top is acceptable!
